Under the Aegis of Delhi Legal Services Authority, North-East Delhi, Karkardooma and with the permission of Sh. Lalit Kumar Secretary, DLSA North-East Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, the Centre of Legal Education organized a students visit to National Lok Adalat, Karkardooma Court.

#### **Objective**:

The purpose of the court visit was to acquaint students with the legal procedure and filing of the cases along with the clerical, official and procedure of the Lok Adalat.

#### Activity done:

The students of CLE, ADGIPS reached the campus of Karkardooma Courts, Delhi at 10: 00 a.m. onwards to observe the working of DLSA and proceedings of Lok Adalat. The students were divided into three groups and were given the opportunity to sit and learn from the procedures and practices of Lok Adalat proceedings. They also had a chance to observe proceedings of Traffic Challan court and Bank loan matters. The visit also led the students to interact with judges and counsel. It was a great opportunity to get direct courtroom experience. Thereafter small refreshment packets were made available to each student by the DLSA.

**Learning Outcome**: The visit to the National Lok Adalat was a truly enriching experience which helped the students to understand the working of Lok Adalat System. The students were highly impressed and motivated to render pro bono services for the betterment of the society.
